Number / Area of ECTS credits:

- ECTS credits workload for semester: at least for 24,0 ECTS credits and not exceed 30,0 ECTS credits (for a full year of studies at the UA, ECTS workload should account at least for 48,0 ECTS credits and no more than 60,0 ECTS credits);
- For a full year mobility, the workload must be balanced between semesters;
- Course units directly associated with the field of study under which the application is submitted must account at least for half of the total ECTS workload in the proposed learning agreement.

Portuguese as Foreign Language (PLE):

- We provide Portuguese as Foreign Language (PLE) courses throughout each semester for 4 hours per week completely free of charge for exchange students and they are strongly recommended to include it;
- Each course unit accounts for 6,0 ECTS credits and is not considered in the maximum limit (that means a student can apply for 36,0 ECTS per semester if including PFL course unit);

English level:

Before applying, please see the bilateral agreement and the requested / recommended level of English to send / receive students.

Accommodation:

- A limited number of rooms are available at the halls of residence for our Incoming students and the International Office cannot guarantee accommodation for all them. These are reserved mainly for students with special needs or from more distant countries. Other available places will be distributed on a first-come-first-served basis.
