At undergraduate level:

The **Master Grande Ecole Program** has the "Grade de Master" (highest label for a diploma) and is also accredited by the French Ministry of Higher Education, Research & Innovation. The **MBA Strategy & Business Innovation** is a one-year program recognized by the French Government.

Health & student insurance

All students are required to provide a copy of their International Health Insurance Certificate (covering repatriation, civil liability and extra medical costs) as well as :

EU-residents : a valid copy of your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)

Non-EU residents : a certificate proving that you applied for the French Health Scheme (Sécurité Sociale). It is mandatory and free.
